- Would you like to hear from the Educational Psychology Team what you can do to support your child, and where else you can access support?
- Would you like to meet other parents/carers who share your concerns?

Bradford Educational Psychology Team are offering FREE workshops for parents and carers, via the Mental Health Champions project, which is commissioned and funded by the Clinical Commissioning Groups in Bradford. Parents and carers are eligible if the child/young person (up to age 18) in their care lives in the Bradford area.

The focus of our input this year will cover the effects of coronavirus on mental health and emotional wellbeing.

The topic for the February session is supporting children and young people who are struggling with perceptions that they are falling behind with school work/studies.
