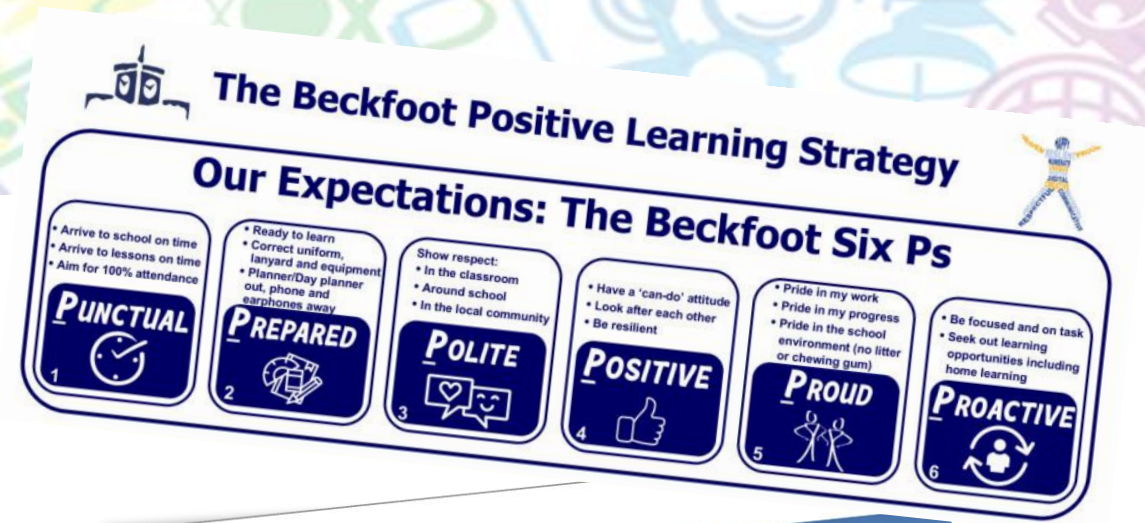
- We are so excited to bring back EW 2022!

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Itinerary – Monday-Tuesday

Thursday 21/07/22: Liverpool Cathedral and return to Bingley

- 09:00 Check out YHA Albert Dock
 - 10:00 Liverpool Cathedral tour – curriculum link RE and Humanities
 - 14:30 Return to YHA to collect bags and travel to train station
 - Train leaves Liverpool 15:54, returns to Bingley 18:02. Pupils return home independently/picked up at Bingley train station
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Arrangements for meals/refreshments

- Breakfast and tea will be available at YHA Albert Dock (possible provision for lunch as well). Of course it is fine to buy refreshments in the daytime but within reason.
 - You are welcome to send your child with refreshments for the train journey but please – no energy drinks.
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Rooming

- Rooming will be organised on arrival depending on availability at YHA.
 - Please check with your child about potential rooming arrangements closer to the time, and contact me with any questions if necessary.
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Expectations in the YHA

- Evenings will be spent at leisure – we will take sporting kit/indoor activities and there will be provision in the YHA but pupils are welcome to spend their time however they choose.
 - We will expect pupils to be in rooms ready for bed by: 9:30 (y7), 9:45 (y8), 10:00 (y9) to allow for use of facilities to be staggered. We will check at 10:00 and again at 11:00.
 - We will not be the only guests and so behaviour in the evenings/night-time needs to be exemplary – in terms of representing the school but also for safeguarding reasons.
 - Any poor or unsafe behaviour, especially if resulting in safeguarding issues, may immediately risk a pupil's place on the trip and that decision will be up to myself and/or Sabah.
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Kit list

- Three changes of clothes – one for each day.
 - Practical outdoor shoes for walking around the city.
 - Wet weather clothing (coat).
 - Casual wear for the evenings in the YHA.
 - Suitable sleeping wear.
 - Towel and suitable toiletries – toothbrush, toothpaste, shower gel, shampoo, deodorant.
 - Sun cream/after-sun – we will be spending significant time outside.
 - Suitable spending money – see relevant slide.
 - Phone/watch for timekeeping – see relevant slide.
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Money

- Spending money – please make this decision for yourselves.
- Pupils will have the opportunity to go shopping if they wish, though the Albert Dock area has a number of free or low-priced attractions so there is no requirement to bring a lot of money. Souvenir shopping and refreshments will be available.
- Some attractions (e.g. Wheel of Liverpool) have an extra cost.
- Please be aware that pupils will be required to look after their own money (except by arrangement with myself and/or Sabah). There may be a safe or similar at the YHA.
- Please be aware we will be unable to lend pupils money except in extreme circumstances.

Important expectations

- Expectations of behaviour and responsibility will be high. Outside of scheduled visits pupils may visit any attractions but if failing to check in/meet us at the scheduled time then the pupil/s in question may be required to accompany us instead for as long as necessary.
- Pupils are welcome to accompany us around attractions if they wish to.
- **Use of phones/social media:** We understand that this is a large part of children's lives but any inappropriate use will mean these devices are confiscated for as long as necessary. Any phone/social media use resulting in safeguarding issues may risk a place on the trip.
- Any complaints of **bullying/negative behaviour** will be taken and dealt with seriously.
- **Clothing needs to be appropriate** for a school trip – pupils may be asked to change if this is not the case. Please try and avoid clothing that is revealing/has inappropriate slogans/is likely to attract negative attention. Please try and avoid Premier League football kit.
- **Please avoid sending your child with energy drinks.** We will also not allow energy drinks to be bought.
